F. According to the U.S. immigration laws, crimes that will trigger denial of visas include:

F-1. Extrajudicial killing (defined as deliberated killing not authorized by a previous judgment pronounced by a regularly constituted court affording all the judicial guarantees)

F-2. Torture or cruel, inhuman, or degrading treatment or punishment;

F-3. Prolonged detention without charges;

F-4. Causing the disappearance of persons by the abduction or clandestine detention of those persons

F-5. Other flagrant denial of the right to life, liberty, or the security of persons.

F-6. Ordering, inciting, assisting, or otherwise participating in genocide.
