Ms. Yao Caiwei Dies as a Result of Persecution

(Clearwisdom.net) Falun Gong practitioner Ms. Yao Caiwei's husband, Mr. Zhang Tao, was tortured to death in police custody in 2002. Their 22-year-old daughter Ms. Zhang Jianhui, also a practitioner, was sentenced to ten years in prison. Under the intense pressure of the persecution, Ms. Yao suffered a mental collapse and became physically incapacitated. She died on May 18, 2010. The prison authority refused to let her daughter see Ms. Yao before she died, and refused to let her attend her mother's funeral.

After the persecution of Falun Gong began in 1999, the police arrested Ms. Yao, her husband, and their daughter several times between 1999 and 2000, because they went to Beijing to appeal for justice for Falun Gong.

On November 10, 2001, Mr. Zhang was taken to the Harbin Police Department and tortured for 12 days. He was sentenced him to three years in the Changlinzi Forced Labor Camp in Harbin City. Mr. Zhang was beaten in the labor camp and experienced severe pain afterwards. The doctor at Harbin 2nd Hospital found that he had internal injuries and that he retained fluid in his abdomen. Mr. Zhang was released for medical reasons.

On April 19, 2002, just nine days after Mr. Zhang was released, agents from the 610 Office (an agency instituted specifically to persecute Falun Gong) stormed into the couple's house and dragged them into a police vehicle. The police beat Mr. Zhang and took him back to the Changlinzi Camp. He was locked in solitary confinement. On July 30, 2002, the camp administrators alerted Mr. Zhang's brother that he had died of "heart disease." When his brother went to tend to the body on August 2, 2002, he saw that Mr. Zhang's neck was swollen and bruised, and one of his arms was fractured.

After the April 19 arrest, Ms. Yao was put in the Wanjia Forced Labor Camp. When her husband died, she asked to see his body but the authorities refused and had him cremated. Their daughter was also arrested on April 19. The guards beat her and disfigured her face. She was sentenced to ten years' imprisonment and has been detained in the Heilongjiang Province Women's Prison since January 2003.

Ms. Yao suffered a mental collapse as a result of the death of her husband, her daughter's imprisonment, and due to the fact that her son was nowhere to be found. She cried constantly and her vision became blurred. In the winter of 2008, her family helped Ms. Yao see the prison director and requested that Zhang Jianhui be released to take care of her mother. The request was denied. After returning home, Ms. Yao's condition worsened. On May 18, 2010, she had a convulsion and died.

Falun Dafa, also known as Falun Gong, is a practice for benefiting physical health and elevating the mind. Introduced by Mr. Li Hongzhi in China, the practice consists of five gentle exercises including meditation, and diligent effort on the part of practitioners to follow the universal principles of Truthfulness-Compassion-

Forbearance in daily life. Falun Gong is not only beneficial to one's own health and well-being, it also benefits others. Although the practice originated in China, today it is practiced throughout the world by people of all races and walks of life. In the face of the brutal and most persecution perpetrated on them by the Chinese Communist Party, Falun Gong practitioners have found the spiritual strength to resist peacefully and tirelessly by upholding the principles Truthfulness-Compassion-Forbearance.
